"Be holy, for I am holy" Lev 11:44

We are all called to be holy- by living our lives with love and by bearing witness in everything we do, wherever we find ourselves -. Pope Francis Apostolic Exhortation Gaudete et Exsultate

We each have our own individual path to holiness which invites and brings out the best in us. Let's today spend time thinking about our true self - the person we are called to be.

Some words and phrases that can point to being holy include:

being present, genuine, approachable, honest, consistent,

giving, forgiving,


