Root to Tip New Zealand's nationwide cooking competition for kids.

Tomorrow, two students from Holy Cross, Manuela and Amelia have been selected to cook at the RaboDirect Root to Tip regional heat for Wellington. The girls will be following the guidelines below:

- Incorporate the Root to Tip theme – use as much of the fruit and vegetable as possible e.g. pumpkin soup served in a pumpkin bowl, roast beetroot salad featuring roasted beetroot and leaves
- Use seasonal fruit and vegetables, ideally sourced from school, community and home gardens
- Creative use of ingredients to create delicious dishes
- Can be prepared in two hours max (both dishes)
- Produces minimum wastage (waste will be weighed)
- Kids can choose to design an entrée and main or a main and dessert.
