Prayer for our travelling Year 7/8 students

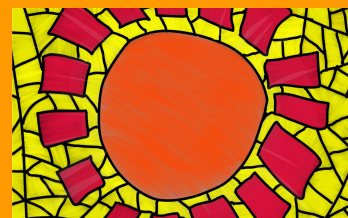
Dear St. Christopher,

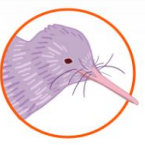
